

HB 1482 Intergenerational Advisory Committee

HB 1482 states that the Intergenerational Poverty Advisory Committee is created to assist the Taskforce. The bill states "the advisory committee must include diverse, statewide representation from public, nonprofit, and for-profit entities. The committee membership must reflect regional, racial, and cultural diversity to adequately represent the needs of all children and families in the state."
