Dear Governor Inslee:

This is in response to your September 10, 2014, appeal of the denial of your request for Individual Assistance under major disaster declaration FEMA-4188-DR. You specifically appealed the denial of Individual Assistance for Okanogan County and the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation.

On August 18, 2014, a supplemental joint Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) was conducted to assess the newly identified damage to dwellings that were not included in the initial PDA.

After a thorough review of all of the information contained in the initial request and appeal, we reaffirm our original findings that the impact to individuals and households from this event was not of the severity and magnitude to warrant the designation of Individual Assistance under major disaster declaration FEMA-4188-DR. Therefore, I must inform you that your appeal for Individual Assistance is denied.
