Notice of Judicial Vacancy Spokane County Superior Court

On March 15, 2025, the Honorable Raymond F. Clary announced his resignation from the bench effective June 30, 2025. Governor Bob Ferguson is now seeking interested and qualified members of the Washington State Bar Association to submit applications to fill Judge Clary's position in the Spokane County Superior Court. To be considered for this vacancy, applicants should promptly submit the completed Uniform Judicial Evaluation Questionnaire; a brief resume (no more than 3 pages); the information waiver (also found at the link above); and at least two letters of recommendation. Additionally, applicants should schedule judicial evaluations with the judicial district bar association and the statewide affinity bar associations. All applications must be completed and submitted to the Governor's Office by **Monday, May 5, 2025**. Any judicial evaluation ratings should be submitted to the Governor's Office of Legal Counsel as soon as possible.
