**Substitute Senate Bill No. 5195**

Relating to the capital budget.

Relating to state general obligation bonds and related accounts.

Relating to establishing a tax on certain business activities related to surpluses generated under the zero-emission vehicle program.

**Engrossed Substitute House Bill No. 2081**

Relating to funding public schools, including higher education, health care, social services, and other programs and services to benefit Washingtonians by modifying business and occupation tax surcharges, rates, and the advanced computing surcharge cap, clarifying the business and occupation tax deduction for certain investments, and creating a temporary business and occupation tax surcharge on large companies with annual revenues with more than \$250,000,000.

**Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill No. 5813**

Relating to increasing funding to the education legacy trust account for public education, child care, early learning, and higher education by creating a more progressive rate structure for the capital gains tax and estate tax.

**Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill No. 5814**

Relating to funding public schools, health care, social services, and other programs and services to benefit Washingtonians by modifying the application and administration of certain excise taxes.

Relating to improving the administration of tax preferences by adopting recommendations from the tax preference performance review process, eliminating obsolete tax preferences, clarifying legislative intent, and addressing changes in constitutional law.

Relating to fiscal matters.
