Notice of Judicial Vacancy Grant County Superior Court

Effective January 1, 2026, Governor Ferguson appointed the Honorable Tyson Hill to the Washington State Court of Appeals, Division Three. Accordingly, Judge Hill has announced his resignation from the Grant County Superior Court effective December 31, 2025. Governor Bob Ferguson is now seeking interested and qualified members of the Washington State Bar Association to submit applications to fill Judge Hill's position on the Grant County Superior Court. To be considered for this vacancy, applicants should promptly submit the completed Uniform Judicial Evaluation Questionnaire; a brief resume (no more than 3 pages); the information waiver (also found at the link above); and at least two letters of recommendation. Additionally, applicants should schedule judicial evaluations with the judicial district bar association and the statewide affinity bar associations. All applications must be completed and submitted to the Governor's Office by **Monday, December 8, 2025**. Any judicial evaluation ratings should be submitted to the Governor's Office of Legal Counsel as soon as possible.
