I am deeply saddened by the death of former Governor Daniel Evans, 98, and direct that Washington state and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff on **Tuesday, November 12, 2024** in honor and remembrance of former Governor Daniel Evans, who passed on Friday, September 20, 2024.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on **Thursday, November 14**, **2024**.

Please notify all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will take place on November 12, 2024, at the University of Washington at 3:00 PM.
