SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

Pursuant to the attached White House notification and 4 USC 7 (m), I hereby direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff **immediately**, in honor and remembrance of United States Representative Donald McEachin from Virginia.

Flags should remain at half-staff until midnight, **Tuesday, November 29, 2022**, or first thing Wednesday morning, November 30, 2022.
