**SUBJECT:** Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Bellevue Police Officer Jordan Jackson, 34, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on <u>**Tuesday, December 6, 2022.</u>** Officer Jackson died in the line of duty on Monday, November 21, 2022.</u>

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on **Tuesday**, **December 6**, **2022**.

## Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will take place on December 6th, at the Meydenbauer Center in Bellevue at 1:00 pm.
