**SUBJECT:** Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Everett Police Officer Dan Rocha, 41, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on **Monday, April 4, 2022.** Officer Rocha died in the line of duty on Friday, March 25, 2022.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on Monday, April 4, 2022.

## Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will take place on April 4th, at the Angel of the Winds Arena in Everett at 1:00 pm.
