SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I hereby direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff on <u>Monday</u>, <u>May 29</u>, <u>2023</u>, in recognition of Memorial Day. This federal holiday is in remembrance of those who lost their lives while serving in the country's armed forces.

I have no objection to agencies lowering the flags at the close of business on Friday, May 26, 2023. Flags should remain at half-staff until noon on **Monday**, **May 29, 2023**, or first thing Tuesday morning, May 30, 2023.

Please notify all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.
