SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Clark County Sheriff's Deputy Jeremy Brown, 46, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on <u>Tuesday, August 3, 2021</u>. Deputy Brown died in the line of duty on Friday, July 23, 2021.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on Tuesday, August 3, 2021.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will take place on August 3, 2021 at the Ilani Event Center in Ridgefield at 1:00 pm.
