SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Washington State Patrol Trooper Justin R. Schaffer, 28, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>August 5</u>, <u>2020</u>. Trooper Schaffer died in the line of duty on Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on Wednesday, August 5, 2020.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will take place on August 5, 2020, at 11:00 am, in Lewis County and will be limited to 400 attendees.
